Re: Visit of Total Eren management in Uzbekistan and next steps of Tutly solar PV project

Dear Sirs,

In collaboration with the Ministry for Investments and Foreign Trade of the Republic of Uzbekistan, JSC Uzbekenergo and the Khokimiyat of Samarkand and Nurobod, Total Eren has made significant progress on the development of the Tutly 200 MW_{AC} solar PV plant.

Among other recent developments, we have had written confirmation from the Nurobod Khokimiyat that a 600-ha parcel had been reserved for our project, we have physically marked the land plot in presence of Total Eren representatives and the local authorities' surveyor, and we are progressing on a number of technical studies including topographic studies, geotechnical studies, environmental and social impact assessment and on-site measurements of solar irradiation.

We are progressing on the design of the PV plant and have launched the Request for Proposal to select our Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) contractor and on the financing side, we have engaged in detail with international lenders who consistently show great interest for our project.

In light of this positive momentum on the development of our project and given recent developments such as the appointment of a new Minister of Investments and Foreign Trade, the appointment of a Minister of Energy and the planned restructuring of JSC Uzbekenergo, we are kindly proposing to organize meetings between Total Eren executive management and the relevant governmental authorities in charge of our project.

We propose to organise our meetings alongside the official visit in Uzbekistan of the Secretary of State to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the French Republic, M. Jean Baptiste Lemoyne. The purpose of this visit planned on the 16th and 17th of April 2019 is among others to assess the progress of the various agreements signed in October 2018 during the official visit of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Mr Shavkat Mirziyoyev in France.

We propose to organize the following meetings, subject to the availability of the relevant ministers, preferably on the 17th of April, or alternatively on the 16th of April:

- Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Mr Elyor Ganiev;
- Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Minister of Finance, Mr Djamshid Kuchkarov;
- Minister of Energy, Mr Alisher Sultanov;
- Minister for Investments and Foreign Trade, Mr Sardor Umurzakov;
- Deputy Minister for Investments and Foreign Trade, Mr Shukhrat Vafaev;

We also suggest to meet with the relevant representatives of JSC Uzbekenergo or its successor company.

We remain at your disposal shall you have further suggestions of meetings or if you would like to propose alternative timeslots.

On Total Eren side, the participants are expected to be:

- Ms Fabienne Demol, Executive Vice-President, Global Head of Business Development;
- Mr Antoine Garret, Vice-President, Business Development, Asia;
- Mr Emmanuel Terroir, Senior Business Developer; and / or
- Mr Christophe Challe, Business Developer.


