Dear Honorable Minister,

I have the honor to update you on the progress of bilateral cooperation on the Water Supply Improvement Project in Tashkent (hereinafter "WSIP").

We presented the preliminary report of the Master Plan of WSIP on March 14th and we think that the Uzbekistan government is considering K-water as a cooperative partner to implement the Tashkent Water and Wastewater Modernization Project.

In addition, the President of Republic of Korea is going to visit Uzbekistan and discuss expansion of greater economic cooperation in the near future. So we suggest that the bilateral cooperation between the two countries for the implementation of WSIP be included in the MOU to be signed by the two Presidents. It would be very helpful for K-water to take a grant budget for the pilot project of WSIP from the Korean government.
