



Distribution of the total volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries, in %










The total growth rate over the previous year, in %




Distribution of agricultural production by farm categories for 2019 (in %)




Sown area of all crops for the 2019 harvest, thousand hectare



Distribution of total production by farm categories




Volume distribution by regions and growth rate (to the same period in 2018)






Forecast of production of main types of products and growth rate (in% by 2018) for 2020-2021.






Forecast of production of main types of products and growth rate (in% by 2018) for 2020-2021.








Dynamics of export of fruits and vegetables in 2018-2020 (3rd quarter) (mln USD)







The main countries of export of fruits and vegetables products in 2017-2019














As of 2018, the level of industrial processing of fruits and vegetables amounted to 2.1 million tons or about 13% of the total harvest.

Vegetables accounted for 54.9% of the total processing and 24.2% of the fruit. The rest of the processing - 20.9% - came together for melons, legumes and grapes.

The peculiarity of the market is a relatively low level of competition in the market - a total of 348 enterprises carry out their activities.



Price for meat (beef) in Uzbekistan exceeds prices in the countries of the CIS and remains at the level of high-income countries.

- In 2019, all categories of livestock farms of the republic produced **2,473.6 thousand tons of meat in live weight** (1,7% more than in 2018).
- As of September 1, 2020, the total number of cattle reached **12,756.6 thousand heads.**
- 73 kilograms of meat was produced per capita
- 75,5% of meat consumed is beef.








Quantity of heads of animal husbandry in million pcs



The demand for livestock feed in 2018 year in our country was 120 million tons, but last year only 47 million tons were produced (demand is satisfied by 40%).



This means that animal breeders are able to grow feed themselves 10 times cheaper than meal and

Around the world, silage and combined feed are used for fattening livestock.



On one hectare it is possible to grow up to 100 center (10 ton) of fodder wheat.

There is as a re-culture, an intensive variety was grown of corn in Yangiyul district, from which 50-60 tons of silage were obtained, the cost of 1 kilogram of which was only 150 sums. A kilogram of husk is on the market more than 2 thousand sums.







The cost of feeding the local livestock 20 thousand sums = 500 grams of meat every day






Quantity fowl by years in million heads
